DESCRIPTIONS

WHEREAS, the current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District (District) and the International Union American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees No. 1 (AFSCME Local 1) is in effect until 2029

WHEREAS, Local 1 and the District have agreed to changes to the job descriptions to Administrative Aide I, II, and III regarding SB 1100,

WHEREAS, Local 1 and the District have agreed to the removal of any reference to the requirement of a driver's license for the listed positions,

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District desires to approve the new job descriptions and attach them to the existing MOU, which was established as a term from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Directors of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District hereby approves the amendments to the job descriptions in the Memorandum of Understanding with the International Union American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees Local No. 1, attached hereto as Exhibit A.




