

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-32
OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
GEORGETOWN DIVIDE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT
AWARDING CONTRACT TO QUALITY PAINTING AND SANDBLASTING TO PROVIDE
TANK COATING SERVICES FOR ANGEL CAMP STORAGE TANK AND TO WEST
COAST COATING CONSULTANTS FOR TANK COATING INSPECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (“Board”) of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District (“District”) is committed to delivering safe reliable drinking water to Divide communities; and

WHEREAS, Angel Camp Storage Tank was constructed in 1971 with a capacity of 500,000 gallons; and

WHEREAS, Angel Camp Storage Tank is supplied by Sweetwater Treatment Plant and serves the communities of Greenwood, Cool and Pilot Hill; and

WHEREAS, Evaluation of tank coating has determined it has exceeded life expectancy and is due for rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, On September 11, 2025, the District issued a Request for Bid (“RFB”) associated with construction services for Recoating Angel Camp Water Storage Tank and Request for Proposal (“RFP”) for Inspection Services for Recoating Angel Camp Water Storage Tank; and

WHEREAS, A total of four bids and four proposals were received; and

WHEREAS, Quality Painting & Sandblasting was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a bid of \$563,250 and West Coast Coating Consultants as a qualified inspection consultant with a cost of \$35,340; and

WHEREAS, the 2025/2026 Capital Improvement Plan (“CIP”) allocated \$675,000 for Angel Camp Tank Coating Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of Georgetown Divide Public Utility District hereby finds, determines, and resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. The awards for the RFB and RFP are as follows:

- a. The construction contract for the Angel Camp Tank Coating project is awarded to Quality Painting & Sandblasting in the amount of \$563,250.
- b. The inspection service for the Angel Camp Tank Coating project is awarded to West Coast Coating Consultants in the amount of \$35,340
- c. The General Manager is authorized to execute the contract with Quality Painting & Sandblasting and West Coast Coating Consultants and take all necessary actions to proceed with the project.

- d. The General Manager is authorized to execute change orders up to 10 percent of the awarded, if necessary.


SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of adoption. The Secretary shall certify the adoption of this Resolution.




