

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-32
OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
GEORGETOWN DIVIDE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT
SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING
TO ESTABLISH THE PROPOSITION 4 APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT
FOR THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District (District) is required by Proposition 4 to set a date for a public hearing on the appropriations limits for the District; and

WHEREAS, the hearing set for the Board's Regular Meeting of July 14, 2020, at 2:00 PM will be advertised and noticed as required by law. At said hearing the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District will consider all comments by interested persons; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Appropriations Limit is \$2,909,025.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District that the Public Hearing to establish the Proposition 4 Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 is set for July 14, 2020, at 2:00 PM.




