

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-08**  
**OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE**  
**GEORGETOWN DIVIDE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT**  
**DECLARING THE PROJECTED WATER YEAR**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2024-01 establishes rules and regulations for irrigation service in the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District, including Section 4, Distribution of Water, which states that the irrigation season shall generally be from May 1 through September 30 of each year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors is authorized to adjust the irrigation season in response to current water supply, forecast conditions, customer demand, and climate conditions, including impacts from fire, by majority vote; and

**WHEREAS**, the Stumpy Meadows Reservoir is currently at full capacity of 21,206 acre-feet as of March 19, 2025, and staff projects a normal water year with adequate storage to support the 2025 irrigation season; and

**WHEREAS**, the District's forecast tool predicts Stumpy Meadows Reservoir will maintain sufficient capacity to support a five-month irrigation season under normal demand conditions, with an anticipated end-of-season storage level of approximately 16,332 acre-feet; and

**WHEREAS**, staff and the Irrigation Advisory Committee recommended a May 15, 2025, start date for the irrigation season, concluding October 15, 2025.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GEORGETOWN DIVIDE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT THAT:**


1. The 2025 irrigation season will begin on May 15, 2025, and end on October 15, 2025.
2. The District declares a normal water year based on current reservoir storage and projected conditions.
